Dr Brooke trained in Medicine at Cambridge University and the London Hospital Medical College, qualifying as a doctor in 1982. Following several years of work in hospitals mainly in Paediatrics and Anaesthetics he has worked as a General Practitioner in Swindon since 1991. He has earned diplomas in Child Health, Anaesthetics, and Obstetrics and Gynaecology from the Royal Colleges in London.

Dr Brooke has a particular interest in the importance of physical, psychological and spiritual factors in human health and illness. After qualifying as a doctor he continued his studies to gain diplomas in Religious Studies and in Clinical and Pastoral Counselling and a degree in Religious Education. These have broadened and undergirded his holistic approach.

Dr Brooke is a tutor for the Certificate and Diploma courses in Integrative Counselling with the Willows Counselling Service in Swindon. He is a member of the British Society for Ecological Medicine and he is currently pursuing further studies in Environmental and Nutritional Medicine.

Dr Brooke has recently completed a Practitioner level NLP training in the College of Nutritional Education and Lifestyle Management in Wokingham and has been gradually incorporating insights and techniques from NLP into his medical and counselling work.
